

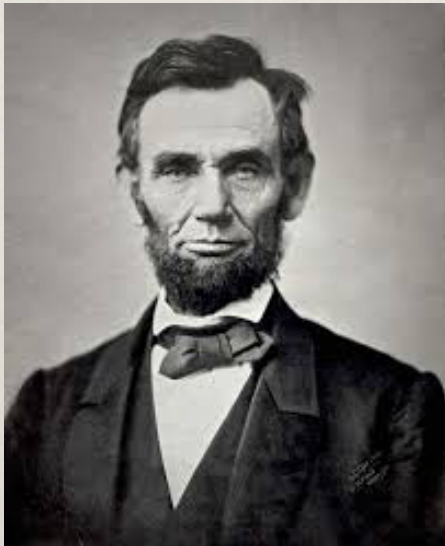

The Presidents

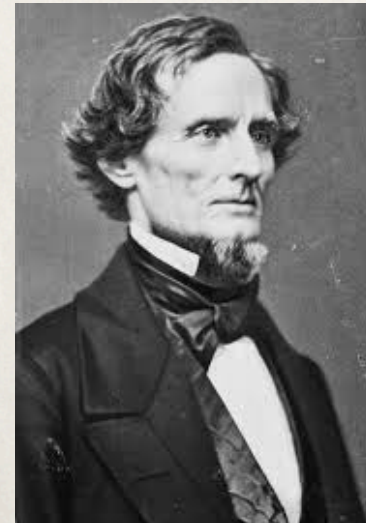
UNION- Abraham Lincoln

- * Successful lawyer
- * Unsuccessful in senatorial election



CONFEDERACY- Jefferson Davis

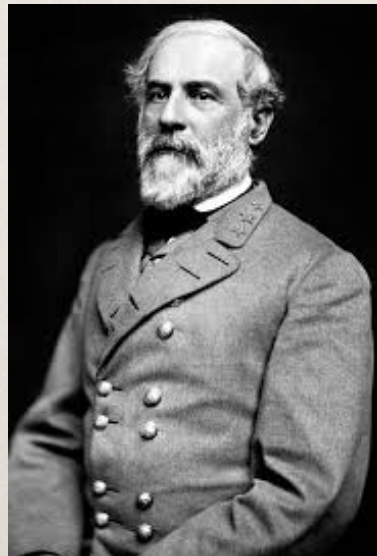
- * Senator of Mississippi
- * Gave the “green light” to attack Fort Sumter



Generals

UNION- Ulysses S. Grant

- * Captain (Mexican-American War)
- * Volunteered for the Civil War
- * A.k.a. “Unconditional surrender”
- * Battle of Shiloh



CONFEDERACY- Robert E. Lee

- * Ended the rebellion at Harper's Ferry
- * Offered a position to command the Union forces
- * 1st & 2nd Battle of Bull Run
- * Seven Day's Battle
- * Escaped Antietam

Soldiers



- * Young (Average age: 25)
- * 40% were 21 or younger
- * From all walks of lives
- * African Americans were not allowed to enlist
- * Would later change

African Americans

UNION

- * Not allowed to enlist
 - * Navy accepted them regardless
- * Spies (Harriet Tubman)
- * Later on became soldiers
 - * Emancipation Proclamation
